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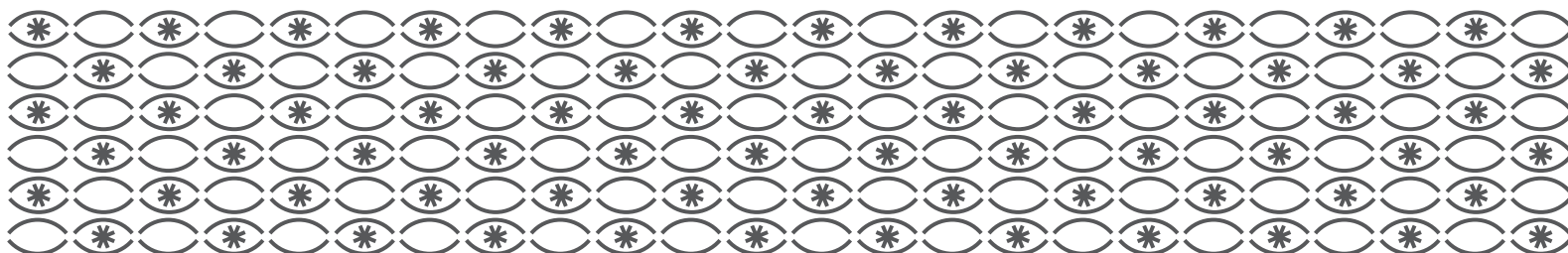

## Shared Structures: Contemporary Embroidery And Weaving Workshop With Czech, Slovak And Hungarian Designers

This is a practical workshop suitable for all ages. The topic is contemporary embroidery and weaving used by young designers. Participants will be working with various materials and techniques, some traditional, some recycled, and some newly developed by the designers. The individual pieces of embroidery will later be attached to form a large collective canvas. Material, tools and guidance will be provided. Drop-in sessions.

The workshop will be led by **Tereza Rosalie Kladošová**, assisted by her colleagues from the Academy of Arts, Architecture and Design in Prague. Tereza has a long term interest in embroidery which forms an essential part of her garments. The techniques used in this workshop are inspired by the 1960's technology of weaving chemlon into a special meshwork called tapiko. Using merino wool and different types of meshworks, Tereza playfully recycled the technique to create her own wild and beautiful ornaments.

Collaborating designers from Slovakia are **Andrea Pojezdálová**, winner of Best Fashion Graduate 2015, **Petra Kubíková** and **Barbora Kubíčková**. Hungary will be represented by INQ concept designer **Orsolya Csik**.
